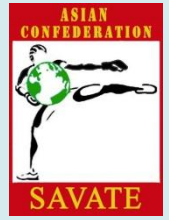




ASIAN SAVATE CONFEDERATION (ASC)



Constitution of Asian Savate (French boxing) Confederation

Chapter 1: Name and Objectives

Article 1: Name

1.1 The name of the confederation is Asian Savate Confederation (ASC). Asian Savate Confederation is the only governing body of Savate in Asia, recognized by International Savate Federation (FISav). Its headquarter is located in Tehran-Iran. Any other country and city of Asia with the decision of the two third majority of the director board members can be the headquarter of ASC.

Article 2: Objectives

The objectives of the Asian Savate confederation are:

2.1 To promote and encourage the development of Savate in all possible manifestations throughout Asia.

2.2 To organize and approve Asian competitions and activities such as: coaching, refereeing and technical seminars in different countries of Asia and issue technical certificates for the mentioned seminar(s).

2.3 To promote cooperation, friendly relations and mutual understanding among its members

2.4 To initially promote, popularize Savate and improve the health of the people in Asia.

2.5 To recognize national members of Savate in Asia.

Article 3: Languages

3.1The official language of Asian Savate confederation is English. Any other languages may be used at meetings providing that adequate translations are available.

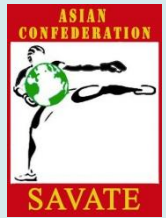
Chapter 2: Membership

Article 4: Membership Eligibility

4.1 Each continental Savate federation, association, union, organization or institute shall automatically become the continental member of the international Savate federation (FISav). Each continental Savate member will be the sole responsible organ for organizing and managing Savate activities in its country.

4.2 Any Savate federation, association, union, organization or institute of all nations or regions of Asia may apply to join in the Asian Savate confederation and become its official member.

4.3 Asian Savate confederation will accept only one member from each country or region. Each member shall be the sole national Savate administrative governing body in that country.

4.4 The director board of Asian Savate confederation has the power to terminate the membership of a member in the case of any violation of ASC constitution. Such a change of membership will be ratified at the next Asian Savate confederation general assembly.

4.5 Following international Olympic committee (IOC) charter, as every world, international, continental and national governing body of sport must be considered as a non-governmental organization (NGO) and it is obligatory to have and act based on autonomy, the same rule is valid for all Savate members of ASC.

4.5.1 Election or changing of any national president of Savate federation, association, union, organization or institute as official member of ASC and FISav is possible only through its general or extra ordinary assembly vote or decision.

4.5.2 Interference of government, ministry of sport, NOC or any other organization(s) in the affairs of any official member of Savate governing body for example: deposing a national member federation, association, union, organization or institute president and appointment a new president is not permissible and means jeopardizing the autonomy. It won't be tolerated by Asian Savate confederation (ASC).

4.5.3 Where unlawful governmental interference is established, ASC may continue to recognize the previously elected president until a lawful election is conducted.

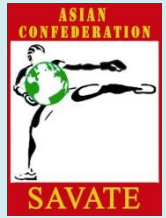
4.6 Each Savate governing body member of ASC must be necessarily independent and autonomous and shall not join or operate as a subordinate body or subclass with other federations or associations of martial arts or any other federation/association/organization.

4.6.1 Joining or working as subclass with other foot & fist martial arts federations or any other organizations is not acceptable by ASC and will be considered as violation of the constitution of ASC. Interaction with these federations or organizations in the case of preserving independence is permissible.

4.7 In the case of any violation of chapter 2 principles, Asian Savate confederation director board has the right to have necessary decisions and measures such as: suspension the membership of the national governing body member.

Article 5: Induction Formalities

5.1 Each Asian Savate federation, association, union, organization or institute shall submit to the Asian Savate confederation secretariat the following documents when applying for membership:

5.1.1 Application in written form.

5.1.2 Completed questionnaire.

5.1.3 Its national constitution in English.

5.1.4 A report on Savate activities carried on at least in the previous year.

5.1.5 An admission fee of three hundred US Dollars (US \$300).

5.2 Asian Savate confederation secretariat shall submit the application packets to the director board for approval. Once an application is approved by the director board, the applicant federation will become a provisional member of the Asian Savate confederation (ASC). A provisional member may become a full member after 2 years of membership, subject to the approval by a simple majority vote of the general assembly.

Article 6: Rights of Members

6.1 To be recognized as the only Savate governing body of the relevant nation or region.

6.2 The right to vote, elect and be elected as stipulated by the constitution.

6.3 To apply for hosting Asian Savate championship and all activities organized or approved by Asian Savate confederation.

6.4 To apply to host the Asian technical, refereeing, judging and coaching seminars organized by Asian Savate confederation.

6.5 To participate in Asian, international and world competitions and activities organized or approved by International Savate federation (FISav) and/or Asian Savate confederation (ASC).

6.6 To send representatives to take part in the international/continental technical, refereeing, judging and coaching seminars organized by FISav/ASC and to obtain the relevant qualifications.

6.7 To recommend Asian/international referees and judges of its nation or region to officiate at the competitions and activities organized and approved by FISav and/or ASC.

6.8 To organize national or regional Savate competitions adopting FISav and/or ASC rules.

6.9 To organize national or regional technical, refereeing, judging and coaching seminars in accordance with FISav and/or ASC rules and teaching materials.

Article 7: Duties of Members

- 7.1** To respect Olympic charter of the International Olympic Committee and spirit of the Olympism.
- 7.2** To support Asian Savate confederation and FISav in their efforts to achieve their objectives.
- 7.3** To observe FISav and ASC constitutions and rules and ensure that constitutions and rules of the members do not conflict with those of the FISav and ASC.
- 7.4** To recognize International Savate Federation (FISav) as the only Savate governing body in the world and Asian Savate confederation (ASC) as the only Savate governing body in Asia and not participating in or support other International & Asian Savate organizations or take part in their activities.
- 7.5** To implement the resolutions of the Asian Savate confederation director board and general assembly.
- 7.6** To implement the resolutions of the International Olympic Committee and world Anti-Doping agency (WADA).
- 7.7** To pay the annual membership fee in time.

Article 8: Membership Fee

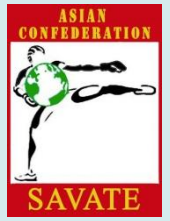
- 8.1** The annual membership fee of each member is three hundred US Dollars (300US \$).
- 8.2** It is obligatory for members to pay the membership fee to Asian Savate confederation before March 31st of each year. The benefits of the membership may be suspended if a member does not pay its membership fee when it is due.
- 8.3** The new members shall pay the membership fee of the year within 30 days of its becoming members approved by the director board.

Article 9: Dismissal, Withdrawal and Suspension of Membership

- 9.1** If a member country of Asian Savate confederation refuses to comply with the constitution or severely jeopardizes the fame and interests of the Asian Savate confederation, the director board may propose to expel the concerned member. Its membership shall be expelled upon approval by the simple majority of the votes from the delegates of the next ASC general assembly.
- 9.2** The following circumstances shall be considered a voluntary withdrawal from ASC membership:
 - 9.2.1** If the member no longer exists or fails to participate in any ASC event for three consecutive years of ASC Calander.
 - 9.2.2** If a member fails to pay its membership fee for three consecutive years.

9.3 If the withdrawn member wishes to resume its affiliation and there is no new member of its nation or region, it shall pay twice the admission fee along with any past due membership fee during its period of absence.

9.4 The director board may suspend or recommend to the expulsion of any member federation, association, union, organization, institute, official or representative(s) whose action(s) seriously damage(s) the reputation, interests, integrity, objectives or governance principles of ASC. Such actions may include but are not limited to:

- a) Serious violations of ASC constitution, regulations or decisions.
- b) Conduct contrary to the principles of fair play, ethics, integrity or sportsmanship.
- c) Activities that bring ASC or sport of Savate into disrepute.
- d) Serious criminal convictions or legal violations that may adversely affect the reputation, credibility or interests of ASC.
- e) Establishing, supporting or participating in unauthorized rival Savate organizations that conflicts with the interests of ASC or FISav.

9.5 The director board may request the legal and disciplinary commission or any other competent commission to review and investigate the matter and submit recommendations.

9.5.1 Before any final decision is taken, the concerned member shall be given an opportunity to present his/her explanations or defense.

9.5.2 Any decision regarding expulsion shall be subject to ratification by the next ASC general assembly.

Chapter 3: International competitions and activities

Article 10: Types of competitions and activities

10.1 The following competitions are hosted by Asian Savate confederation and organized by the members. The competition rules stipulated by the FISav, shall be adopted in the competitions. Every member shall send only one national team for participation but it is possible to nominate maximum 2 athletes of one country per weight category.

10.1.1 The Asian Savate Championships including: Assaut, Combat and Canne, will be organized every year.

10.1.2 Asian Age Categories Shall include senior, junior, youth, cadet and children's categories.

10.2 Any other Asian Savate competitions and activities approved by Asian Savate confederation director board.

Article 11: Rules Relating to Eligibility for Participation

11.1 In the course of the championships, the flag, national anthem and logo of each participating team shall be used in accordance with the resolutions of the international Olympic committee (IOC).

11.2 The technical committee shall deal with all disputes relating to the athlete's eligibility for participation and report to the director board for the final decision.

Article 12: Applying to Host Competitions and Activities

12.1 The candidate members applying to host Asian Savate competitions and activities should observe all the relevant FISav/ASC regulations and what is described in Article 10. Submit all the bidding documents and fulfill obligations stated in the bidding documents.

12.2 Bidding documents for hosting Asian Savate championships shall be mailed to the secretariat six months prior to the convening of the coming ASC general assembly.

12.3 The bidding documents shall include the following but not limited to:

12.3.1 Name of the host country and the host city.

12.3.1.1 Profile of the city (population, size and characteristics).

12.3.1.2 Detailed local maps showing the location of competition area, hotels and airports.

12.3.2 Venue for competition and training.

12.3.3 Letter of support from the national Olympic committee/ ministry of sport/municipality/ city council or any related supporting organization.

12.4 A delegate of the member applying to host the championships shall make a detailed report at the general assembly.

12.5 ASC president can appoint representative(s) to make an inspection of the candidate cities. The representative(s) shall submit a report to the general assembly for the final decision.

Article 13: The Organization of Competitions and Activities

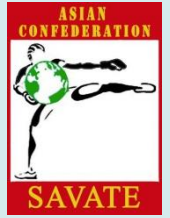
13.1 The competitions and activities organized or approved by Asian Savate confederation (ASC) shall be conducted under the guidance and supervision of the director board.

13.2 The member, hosting the competition and activity shall be responsible for relevant organizing work.

13.3 The technical/competition commission of ASC shall be responsible for technical matters of the competitions.

Chapter 4: Organizational Structure

Article 14: ASC Organizational Structure

The following entities are established to govern and administer the Asian Savate confederation:

- 14.1 Director boards
- 14.2 General assembly
- 14.3 Technical commission
- 14.4 Coaching & Education commission
- 14.5 Medicine & Anti - doping commission
- 14.6 Financial & Marketing & Development commission
- 14.7 Refereeing commission
- 14.8 youth commission
- 14.9 Feminine commission
- 14.10 Legal & Disciplinary commission
- 14.11 Equity commission
- 14.12 Competition commission
- 14.13 Ethics commission

- 14.14 Media commission

- 14.15 Appeal commission

- 14.16 Safeguarding and non-discrimination commission

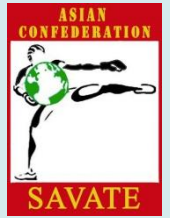
- 14.17 Any other necessary commission(s) by suggestion of the president and approval of the simple majority of the director board.

Article 15: General Assembly

- 15.1 The general assembly is the highest authority of the Asian Savate confederation and shall have the power to decide any matters concerning the Asian Savate confederation.
- 15.2 The general assembly shall be convened every year, generally in conjunction with the Asian Savate Championships. An extraordinary general assembly may be convened upon the initiative of one third of the Members. The secretary general shall inform all the members the date and place no later than 3 months prior to the convening of the general assembly.

15.3 Each member may send only one delegate to attend the ASC general assembly. Each member shall have one vote. The proxy vote in the case of absence of a full member with reason, is accepted. The proxy vote is just one vote given from the absent member to another full member. Each full member is allowed to have maximum one proxy vote.

15.4 The proposals on the modification of the constitution and the competition rules submitted by the members shall be sent to the secretariat six months prior to the convening of the general assembly. Having compiled the proposals, the secretariat shall send the constitution (draft) two months prior to the convening of the general assembly to the director board for review. The secretariat shall make reviewed drafts available to all the members one month prior to the convening of the general assembly.

15.5 The president of the Asian Savate confederation shall preside over the general assembly. In the case of absence of the president, he/she shall appoint the 1st Vice-President to chair of the general assembly. In the case of absence of the 1st vice president, the general assembly decides the chairperson for that special meeting.

15.6 The quorum required for a general assembly is 50 percent of the total membership plus one. A resolution shall be approved by a simple majority of the members present at the general assembly. The amendment of the constitution and dissolution of the Asian Savate confederation shall be made by the votes of a two-third majority of the members present at the general assembly.

15.7 The documents of the general assembly shall be prepared by the secretariat. The agenda of the general assembly shall include the following items:

15.7.1 Roll call and announcement of the quorum.

15.7.2 Approval of the minutes of the last general assembly.

15.7.3 Report on the work of the Asian Savate confederation by the secretary general on behalf of the director board.

15.7.4 Financial report by the treasurer.

15.7.5 Admission, withdrawal and expulsion of membership.

15.7.6 Approval of the amendment on the constitution and competition rules.

15.7.7 Election of the director board (once every four years).

15.7.8 Scrutinize and approval of the budget and financial report.

15.7.9 Date and place of the next ASC championships and general assembly.

15.7.10 Other matters.

15.8 In the case of any special situation such as: war, pandemic disease outbreak, etc ... the general assembly may hold virtually.

15.8.1 Inviting ASC members to its general assembly or any other necessary meetings is possible through e-mail or other applications. Moreover, voting is possible through ballot or e-mail and other applications.

Article 16: Director Board

16.1 The director board shall be the administrative organ of the Asian Savate confederation (ASC). It will have the authority to deal with and decide all the matters of the Asian Savate confederation in accordance with the constitution during the closing period of the general assembly.

16.2 The director board shall be composed of the following members: President, 1st vice president, vice president, secretary general and treasurer of ASC and 6 members.

16.3 The director board members shall be elected by the general assembly serving terms of four years among the full and active countries members and will be eligible for re-election. President, Vice presidents, secretary general and treasurer of ASC must be elected among the director board members. The power shall be transferred during the period between the end of the election and the end of the Asian Savate championships. The newly elected director board shall perform its duties after the conclusion of the Asian Savate championships.

16.4 The director board shall be responsible for supervising the financial affairs and actions of the Asian Savate confederation.

16.5 The president is elected by simple majority votes of the director board members. He/She shall preside over the director board meeting. In his/her absence, 1st vice president is the chair of the meeting.

16.6 The director board meeting is valid only when simple majority of its members are present. A resolution shall be adopted with the approval of a simple majority vote of the members present in the meeting.

16.7 The director board members are deemed to have resigned and thus forfeit their membership if they fail to attend the director board meetings for three consecutive years.

16.8 The director board members are not permitted to hold any positions at any other Asian Savate organizations (If exists).

16.9 The president presides over all activities of the Asian Savate confederation and represents it.

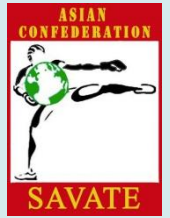
16.10 The president can appoint his/her vice presidents, secretary general, treasurer and other positions of the commissions.

16.10.1 The secretary general shall be responsible for the daily work of the ASC.

16.11 The secretariat is the working organ responsible for the daily operation of the Asian Savate confederation (ASC).

Article 17: Honorary titles

Asian Savate confederation (ASC) may award honorary titles to the effective people and distinguished Individuals of Savate in Asia/world. for example: honorary president to the presidents who retire after serving the ASC.

Article 18: Technical commission

18.1 The technical commission shall be composed of five members: One chair, one vice chair and three members. The committee members shall serve terms of four years and may be eligible for re-appointment.

18.2 The technical committee members must be holders of the international and/or Asian refereeing or judging certificates and at least yellow gloves issued by FISav and/or ASC. In the case of not having enough international or Asian referees or judges, the chair of the technical committee will suggest the members to the president for his/her approval.

18.3 The technical committee shall be responsible for all technical matters of the Asian Savate confederation:

18.3.1 Formulating, revising and supervising the implementation of the competition rules.

18.3.2 Formulating, revising and supervising the implementation of the referees and judges management policy.

18.3.3 Examining and handling technical proposals submitted by the Asian Savate confederation members.

18.4 The technical committee meeting is valid only when over a 50 percent of its members are present. resolutions shall become effective with the approval of a simple majority. The chair of the commission shall make the final decision in the event of a tie vote.

18.5 Recommendations and decisions made by the technical committee are subject to the final approval to the director board.

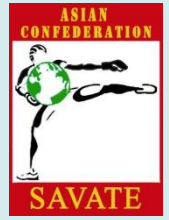
Article 19: Other Commissions

19.1 The chair, the members and the duties of other commissions are defined based on the number of the member countries, suggestion of ASC president and decision of the director board.

19.2 ASC president shall have the authority to appoint and dismiss the chair, vice chair and members of each commission.

Article 20: Nomination, Appointment and Dismission

20.1 Any full member and active ASC member can nominate candidates for the positions in the director board and other commissions. They should send the nomination letters with resume of the candidate(s) to the secretariat three months prior to the election.

20.1.1 The president of ASC must be neutral and shall not simultaneously hold the position of: president, vice president, secretary general and treasurer in any national member countries of ASC.

20.1.2 All candidates for director board election must be represented by their member countries. ASC President shall act in an independent continental capacity and shall not represent the interests of any individual member country while serving in office. For elections to continental or FISav positions, ASC President may be nominated or represented by any ASC member country.

20.1.3 The president of ASC is elected among and by the vote of the director board members. He/she will introduce and appoint the vice presidents, general secretary, treasurer, advisors and all the chairpersons of ASC commissions.

20.1.4 The voting is done by secret ballot.

20.1.5 All ASC director board members, commission members, delegates, coaches, referees, judges, athletes and all participants in ASC activities shall observe the principles of integrity, respect, fairness, non-discrimination, sportsmanship and ethical conduct.

20.1.6 Any ASC director board member, commission member, delegate, official and a person who acts on behalf of ASC has a direct or indirect personal, financial, professional or family interest(s) in a matter under consideration shall disclose such (an) interest(s) and shall refrain from participating in the discussion, decision-making, process or voting related to that matter.

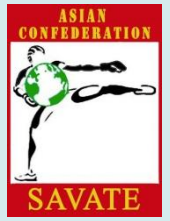
20.1.7 Failure to disclose a conflict of interest may be referred to the ethics commission for scrutiny and appropriate action.

20.2 Nomination of any Asian candidate(s) for different positions in international Savate federation (FISav) is possible based on FISav rules and regulations.

20.3 The expenses of the members of the director board and other committees for attending the Asian Savate confederation meetings, competitions and activities shall be covered by their nominating federations/associations.

Chapter 5: Interpretation of the constitution

The right of interpretation of the constitution is vested in the director board. Any matters not covered by the constitution shall be resolved by the director board and reported to the next general assembly.

The revised constitution of Asian Savate Confederation (ASC) consisting of 5 chapters and 20 articles and 12 pages was approved by the vote of the director boards and the general assembly of ASC members in September 2026.
